



Live Streaming, Video and Photo Policy (2026)

1. Purpose and Scope

This policy applies to all home matches or coaching sessions at Manor Park Road and any away matches where OGCC acts as the streaming lead. The primary purposes are to enhance spectator engagement, provide highlights for members, and support player development.

Photos or Videos may be taken:

- As a coaching aid, to enable coaches to show players their skills/movements
- To Live Stream matches (Senior or Open Age matches only) to allow those who cannot attend matches to view, and to provide highlights for players and supporters.
- Celebrate team success by displaying team pictures in the Club Building
- Promote the clubs activities on the club's website and/or social media pages,

Parents / carers should not be prevented from taking pictures of, or filming, children, young people and players. These are normal family practices and help mark milestones in a player's life and can enhance a player and his or her family's enjoyment of cricket significantly.

We do however, remind parents / carers and others attending matches that they do not have the automatic right to stream or post images of other people's children online. They should also be cautious about tagging other children in any posts that they upload.

2. Mandatory Consents

- Photographs or videos must not be taken at matches or training sessions without prior written consent from parents or guardians for anyone under 18.
- Live streaming cannot occur unless the following conditions are met at least 48 hours before the scheduled start time:
- Opposition Consent: Written confirmation must be obtained from an official of the opposition club (e.g., Secretary or Captain).
- Match Official Consent: Both umpires and scorers must agree to the stream.
- Individual Opt-Out: If any participant (player or official) objects, coaches shall be informed in order to refrain from using videos or photos, and in the event of a live streamed match the stream must not take place.
- The club shall provide the required equipment, and content would be deleted following the coaching session, or if required stored appropriately on encrypted, password protected systems..

3. Safeguarding and Junior Players

- OGCC runs a vibrant junior section. Safeguarding is our priority:
- Under 18s: Written parental/guardian consent is mandatory for any player under 18.
- Identification: We will avoid displaying full names alongside images of children where possible. Scorecard overlays will use initials/surnames only if consent is given.



- Only use images of children in appropriate cricket kit (training or match wear) to prevent inappropriate use.=
- Reporting: Any concerns regarding intrusive photography or stream misuse must be reported immediately to the Club Safeguarding Officer.

4. Prohibited Uses

- Decision Review: The stream is not a Decision Review System (DRS). It must not be used by players or spectators to challenge or vilify umpire decisions.
- Inappropriate Conduct: Any clips used to criticise or harass players or officials on social media will result in disciplinary action under the [Derbyshire Cricket Foundation Social Media Policy](#).
- Privacy Areas: No cameras or recording equipment shall be placed in changing rooms or private areas.

5. Spectator Notification

- OGCC will display prominent signage at the entrance to the ground and near the bar area informing spectators that a live stream is in progress.

6. Administration

- Lead Contact: The OGCC Committee will nominate a Lead Streaming Officer responsible for compliance.
- Data Protection: All footage is processed in accordance with the OGCC Privacy Policy

Agreed Terms

- Safety & Safeguarding: I understand that the club follows the [ECB Safe Hands Policy](#) and that streams will be monitored by a club official.
- Withdrawal of Consent: I understand I can withdraw this consent at any time by contacting the Old Glossop CC Secretary via the Official Club Website.
- Prohibited Use: I agree not to use any captured footage to challenge umpire decisions or to disparage any player, official, or volunteer on social media, in line with the [Derbyshire Cricket Foundation Social Media Policy](#).
- Privacy: Data is handled under the club's [GDPR Policy](#).
